

## **Clint Bowyer Racing BB&T Chevrolet This Weekend at Dover**

**Event:** AAA 400

**Date:** September 27, 2009

**Venue:** Dover International Speedway

### **Clint Bowyer's Dover International Speedway Stat Facts**

Clint Bowyer will pilot Chassis No. 284 from the Richard Childress Racing NASCAR Sprint Cup Series stable. Built new for 2009, this Chevrolet debuted at Atlanta earlier this month, where Bowyer recorded a 29th-place finish.

In seven NSCS starts at Dover International Speedway, Bowyer boasts three top-10 finishes. His best showing at the one-mile oval is an eighth-place finish, which he has accomplished three times. Additionally, the 30-year-old driver has led four laps of competition, has an average starting position of 21.7, an average finish of 14.3 and has completed 99.3 percent of the laps contested (2,780 of 2,800).

### **Loop Data Says**

Bowyer's average running position of 14.113 ranks him 11th best at Dover. His Driver Rating of 90.2 ranks him 10th best among the 55 drivers who have competed at the "Monster Mile" over the last four years.

### **Get to the Points**

Bowyer's 10th-place finish at NHMS allowed him to maintain the 15th position in the NASCAR Sprint Cup Series point standings. Out of the Chase field, the race for 13th place is on. Bowyer trails the current position holder, Kyle Busch, by 157 markers.

### **Through 27 Races**

Over the season's first 27 races, Bowyer has accumulated four top-five and 12 top-10 finishes, an average start of 18.4 and an average finish of 15.9. The two-time NSCS winner has led 40 laps of competition and has completed 7,303 of the 7,636 (95.5 percent) laps contested thus far.

### **Former Winner**

While Bowyer has not yet won at Dover in NSCS competition, he has visited Victory Lane once before. Driving the No. 2 AC Delco Chevrolet in the NASCAR Nationwide Series, Bowyer won the Dover 200 from the 16th starting position on September 23, 2006.

### **Double Duty**

In addition to his driving duties in Sunday's AAA 400, Bowyer, the 2008 NASCAR Nationwide Series champion, will drive the No. 29 Holiday Inn/Holiday Inn Express Chevrolet in Saturday's Dover 200. Live coverage of the event begins Saturday, Sept. 26 at 3 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time. The race will be televised live on ESPN2 and broadcast worldwide on the Motor Racing Network and Sirius XM Satellite Radio.

### **Dover Rewind**

Bowyer finished 11th when the series last competed at Dover in May.

### **Catch the Action**

Live coverage of the AAA 400 from Dover International Speedway begins Sunday, Sept. 27 at 1 p.m. EDT and will be telecast live on ABC. The event will also be broadcast live on the Motor Racing Network and Sirius XM Satellite Radio. Qualifying for the 28th points-paying race on the NASCAR Sprint Cup Series tour will be broadcast live on ESPN2 Friday, Sept. 25 beginning at 3 p.m. EDT and can be heard worldwide on MRN and Sirius XM Satellite Radio.
